### Rules for Conduct at Saint John's University Summer Camps

**Welcome to Saint John's University! We are excited to have you with us and committed to all participants having an enjoyable and safe experience during camp. Outlined below are rules for conduct expected of campers. Disregard for these rules may result in notification to parents/guardians and/or immediate conclusion of camp participation without refund.**

- 1. Respect for others:** Campers are expected to be respectful to other campers, camp counselors, guests, University staff and members of the Saint John's community. Saint John's has zero tolerance for harassment such as inappropriate language, gestures or behavior including bullying, inappropriate comments to or about others, or misconduct. - 2. Respect for property:** Campers and their parents/guardians will be responsible to pay for any damages to property. This includes graffiti and/or physical damages to furniture, fixtures or structures.
- 3. University Grounds and Dorm Rooms:** Campers may only be in their assigned dorm rooms and are not to enter other rooms unless invited. The camp will have designated areas on campus for activities; campers are to respect prohibited areas such as construction areas. If uncertain about any location, speak with a camp counselor/leader.
- 4. Tobacco, drugs, alcohol and weapons are prohibited at all times.**
- 5. If a camper needs to leave camp, let camp leaders know in advance of departure and return times.**
